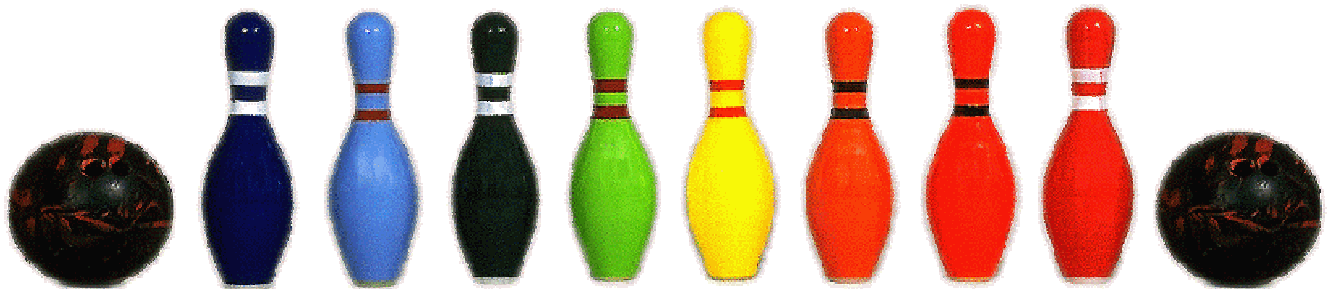

Tournament Rules

- All bowlers must be currently sanctioned and in good standing with USBC.
- This is a scratch tournament.
- Cost is \$100 per bowler: (Prize Fund: \$65.00 / Expenses: \$5.00 / Lineage: \$30.00)
- Prize money awarded to 1 out of every 6 entries.
- Tournament will be limited to the first 72 paid entries received.
- Bowlers are required to check in at 1:30 p.m. on Saturday.
- Bowlers will bowl an 8 game qualifier across 24 lanes. Bowlers assigned to odd lanes will move a pair of lanes to the left after each game, bowlers assigned to even lanes moving a pair of lanes to the right after each game. Starting lane will be assigned at the discretion of tournament director.
- The top 12 bowlers, after the qualifier, will advance to Sunday. Bowlers are required to check in at 8:00 a.m. on Sunday. ***If there are more than 60 entries the top 16 qualifiers will advance to 8 game Round Robin on Sunday.***
- At 8:30 a.m. the top qualifiers will compete in a 6 game Round Robin match play event (***8 game Round Robin match play event if more than 60 entries***). All scores from the qualifier will be dropped. The first 5/7 matches will be the odd number qualifiers: 1,3,5,7,9,11,13,15 (Category A) competing against each other and the even number qualifiers: 2, 4,6,8,10,12,14,16 (Category B) competing against each other in a round robin format. 30 points will be added to the winner of each matches score (15pts will be given to each bowler in the event of a tie) and these totals will be used to determine their position after 5 games. Category A and B bowlers will be combined and re-ordered based on total points. The 6th game will then be a position round between all 12 bowlers.
- The top 5 bowlers, based on total pin fall plus points, regardless of category, will then compete in a one game step ladder format (5 vs. 4, winner advancing vs. 3, etc.) to determine overall winner.
- Employees of 2 Bar Bowl are eligible to compete.
- All play to be governed by USBC Tournament rules.
